Game Time-- 6:30 P. M.

Team whose name appears first on schedule bats first and takes the infield at 6:00 p. m. Managers should not takeover 15 minutes infield. Team whose name appears second on schedule shall bat second and take infield at 6:15 p. m. and stay out ready to begin play.
