Cambridge City, Ind. (Spl.) - Cambridge City's Wampus Cats yesterday overcame an old track Jinx, the Brookville Greyhounds, to win a triangular meet here.

Cambridge City scored 68½ points, Brookville 58½, and Williamsburg, 30.

Brookville had cost Cambridge City teams unbeaten track seasons for the last two years, but yesterday Coach too much balance for the Franklin County Athletes.

Cambridge City scored in every event, while Brookville was unable to land in any of the first three places in the two hurdle races or the broad jump.

Jerry Thompson of Cambridge City and Ron Deffner of Brookville, two of the eastern Indiana Athletic Conference's toprated athletes, put on a hard fight for first places.

Thompson got firsts in the two hurdle races and the broad jump and tied for the first in the high jump. Deffner won the 100 and 200-yard dashes and beat Thompson on the final leg of the half-mile relay.

Charles Carlson of Cambridge City tied a 14-year school record for the 440 when he ran the quarter mile in 55.2 seconds.
